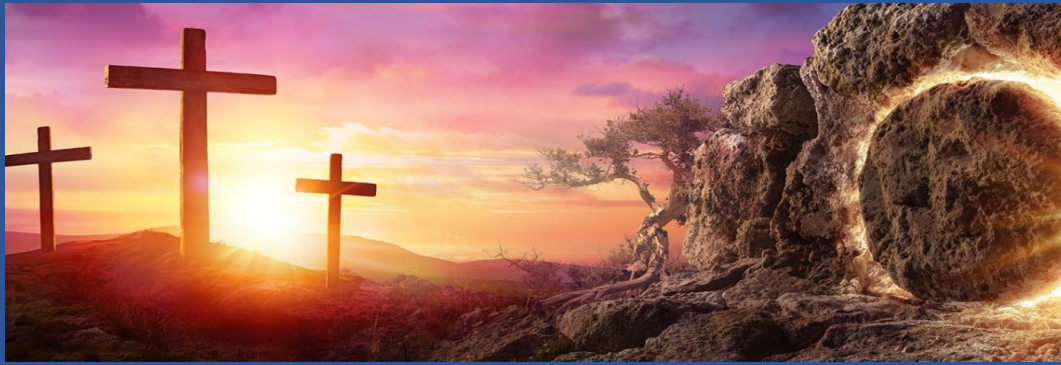

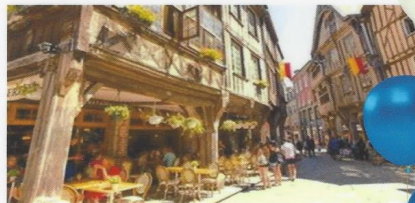


Plédéliac is a small village in Northern Brittany. In the village there is a bakery, bar, butcher's, convenience store, football pitch, tennis courts & small gym.
