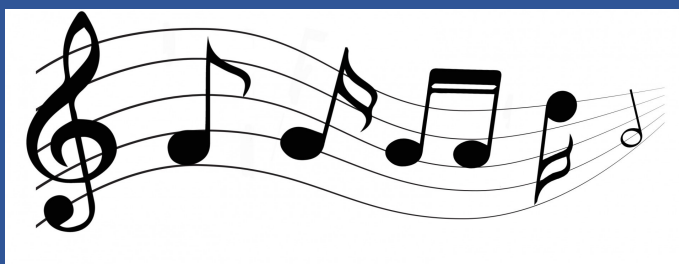
SYMONDSBURY SCHOOL PRESENTS NOYE'S FLUDDE
