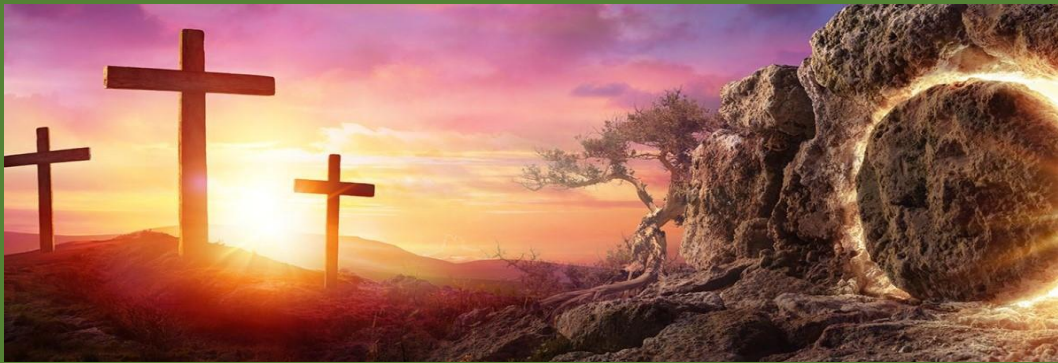

Once completed return it to your Churchwarden.

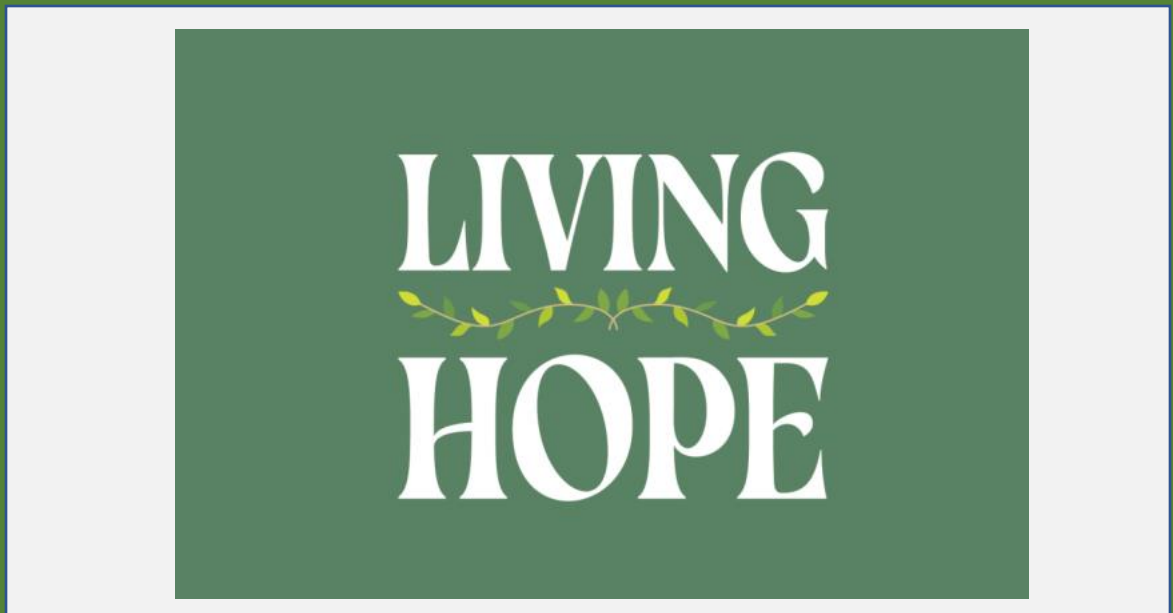

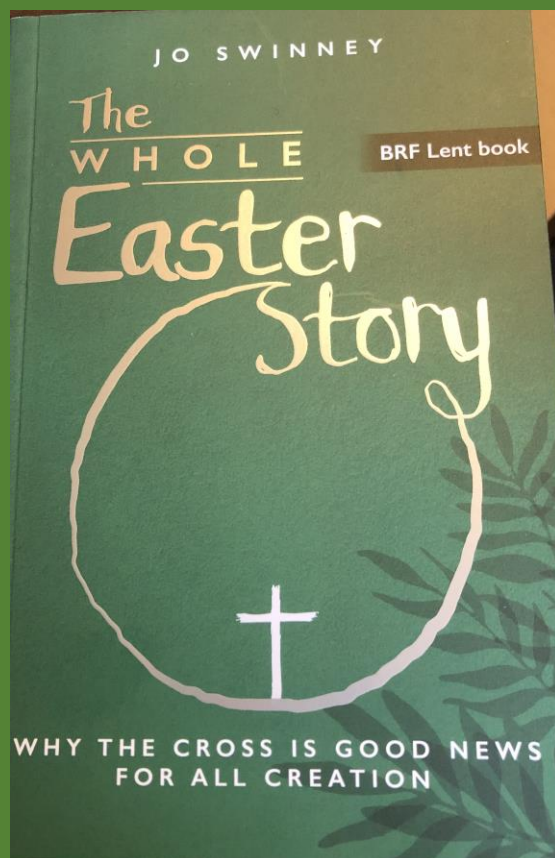
